2019\20 THIRD SERIES PRIZE DETERMINATION RATIONAL

Prize Determiation for each draw will be as follows:

Tuesday 8:00 am - 4 teams - each team plays the other team once over 3 weeks.

The fourth week will be a semi-finals: 1st v 3rd & 2nd vs 4th - points are to be added to the regular season play.

The fifth week will be the finals: 1st v 2nd and 3rd v 4th place.

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams based on win\loss in the finals game.

Tuesday 10:20 am - 8 teams in two pools - (teams 1-4 = Pool "A") & (teams 5-8 = Pool "B"). Teams were randomly selected into each pool.

In this draw each team will play every other team within their pool once over three weeks.

The fourth week is a semi-finals: 1st A v 3rd B, 1st B v 3rd A, 2nd A v 4th B, 2nd B v 4th A - points are to be added to the regular season play.

The fifth week will be the finals: 1st A v 1st B, 2nd A v 2nd B, 3rd A v 3rd B and 4th A v 4th B.

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place teams based on win\loss in the finals game.

Wednesday 9:00 am - 6 teams in one pool.

In this draw each team will play every other team within their pool once over five weeks.

The sixth week will be the finals: 1st v 2nd, 3rd v 4th and 5th v 6th.

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams based on win\loss in the finals game.

Friday 9:00 am - 9 teams in three pools - (teams 1-3 in Pool "A"), (teams 4-6 in Pool "B") & (teams 7-9 = Pool "C"). Teams were randomly selected into each pool.

Each team will play every team within their pool once over a 3 week period and one crossover team from another pool. Teams 9, 2 and 4 will have a bye in weeks 1, 2 & 3 respectively and do not play any crossover games.

Due to the unbalanced nature of this draw - overall round robin standings will be based on the (Highest Average Points per Game). It is very important therefore, to play all 8 ends in this series and to score as many points as possible. (to a maximum of 12 rocks per game)

The fourth week is a semi-finals: This week, the highest overall ranked team will earn a bye go directly into the (final 1 vs 2 game) the following week. The others will play as follows: 2nd v 9th, 3rd v 8th, 4th v 7th, 5th v 6th & 7th v 8th - points are to be added to the regular season play based on the (Highest Average Points per Game) in order to determine the Finals rankings for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th place. The 9th place team will be knocked out and will not be able to compete in the finals.

The fifth week will be the finals: 1st v 2nd, 3rd v 4th, 5th v 6th and 7th v 8th. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place teams based on win \loss in the finals game.

Please review for questions regarding legal spares, late arrivals, defaults etc.

The rules are in place for the benefit of all members and to avoid misunderstandings with regards to player responsibilities.

**Please review the rules carefully and if in doubt, please consult with your skip in order to ensure that the proper number of regular players will be available for each match. Failure to do so could result in a match default for you team!
No more that 2 regular players on a team may be substituted for a given match.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES:

1. The rules and regulations of the O.C.A. except as modified to suit Humber Seniors Club operations.
2. **Eligibility** for membership – men who are at least 50 years of age, or older, or retired.
3. **Classification:**
 - All members will be classified for playing positions by the Rating Committee, subject to review at the end of each series.
 - All new members enter as “Lead” until rated by the Rating Committee. Any former member who has been absent for three years or more shall re-enter as “Lead” until rated.
 - Requests concerning classification of any member must be in writing to the Chair of the Rating Committee. A written decision will be given by the Rating Committee.
4. **Resignations: Members who wish to resign from a team or the club should notify their skip, who will notify the Draw Committee. The Draw Committee, not the team involved, will make a replacement available to the team.**

RULES OF PLAY FOR SCHEDULED LEAGUE GAMES

5. All league games shall be eight (8) ends. Each team should ice **four** club members. At least **two must be regular members of that team. Exception:** If a team member is unable to complete a game, his team may continue with three curlers, Lead and Second positions throwing three rocks each. **If a team member is unable to complete a series, the Draw Committee shall fill that position with another appropriate player for the balance of that series.**
6. If a team member is **late for the start** of a scheduled game, the game will start on time with three players. The late arriving player will join his team at the beginning of the next end. **If a substitute player is used, and the late arriving member is not available before the completion of the 2nd end, then the late arriving member may not join the team in that game.**
7. Should no legal substitute(s) be available, a team may play with three players.
8. **No full end may be started** after 1 hour and 50 minutes from the scheduled starting time of 8:00 or 10:20. Teams are permitted to play half an end (i.e. 1 rock per curler, with a two rock free guard zone) when the end is started after 1 hour and 50 minutes but no later than 1 hour and 55 minutes from the scheduled starting time. If the end is not played, it cannot be counted on the score sheet.
9. The above rule **does not apply** to games scheduled to start at 9:00.
10. It is requested that all players adhere to [Curling Canada: Rule #7 Position of Players](#). There are provisions for a penalty for violation of any portion of this rule.

11. Substitutions in all series

- **Club members are responsible to obtain a substitute for scheduled games they can't play.**
- Players may substitute in **a position at their rated level or one level below or any level above their rating.**
- Members should first consult the list of spares for the series involved.
- All club members may be asked to substitute.
- A club member may substitute any number of times.
- The guiding principle is to try to have **full teams** and **fair play**.
- **Improper substitution shall result in application of the Default Penalty (Rule 13).**

POINT SYSTEM FOR SERIES GAMES

12. Points allotted per game:

- 10 points for a win
- 1 point for each end won
- 1/2 point to each team, for each end blanked, IF PLAYED
- 1/4 point for counting rocks (maximum of 3 points)
- 5 points to each team, for a tied game
- Vice skips will enter the score in the scorebook, and attest to the correctness of all information recorded.

13. **Default Penalty: No points for the offending team and 18 points for the non-offending team.**

14. Average points per game will be used to determine final standings.

15. Ties in the final standings will result in any available prize money being evenly split.

The Executive reserves the right, under special circumstances, to revise the rules. Executive members may be asked to advise members regarding OCA and club regulations.
